Hamilton's Landmark Buildings OPEN Their DOORS to the Public MAY 7 & 8 2011

Hamilton, ON – April 27, 2011 – Hamilton will see over 50 sites open to the public for FREE over the two day event. Sites include 2010's most popular sites; Stinson School Lofts and Auchmar Manor and Estate, as well new sites Hamilton Farmers' Market, St. Matthew Elementary School (Binbrook) and the Golden Horseshoe Live Steamers at the Hamilton Museum of Steam and Technology. Additional Doors Open sites are located throughout Ancaster, Dundas, Flamborough, Stoney Creek, East and West Hamilton, Hamilton Mountain and Downtown Hamilton. Doors Open Hamilton regular hours are from 10:00 a.m. to 4:00 p.m. on Saturday and Sunday, however, many sites will have limited hours and special requirements, so please review the site specifics prior to planning your weekend.
